Value of this position: This position is perfect for the extrovert who enjoys interaction. Take groups of people around the shelter while sharing interesting facts and tips about the Hawaiian Humane Society and animal care. Groups range in age from preschool through senior citizen. Set up the DVD player when a movie is requested. Training is provided. When a request comes up, you can say yes or no depending on whether or not you can accommodate the request on any given day. Be an ambassador for the animals and become a shelter tour guide today!

Frequency of commitment: On call

Expected time on day of activity: Variable. Tours with a movie generally take between 60 – 90 minutes. Many tours are booked on the weekends or after 10:30 am on weekdays.
